

## Hip Hop Show and Winter Concert 2019 Information Sheet

Welcome to our **2019 Hip Hop Show and Winter Concert Performances**. As part of the JLDC dance program, students put on productions each year. We feel that these presentation help to develop our students' poise and sense of achievement.

### DANCER PREPARATION

- **Costumes, accessories, and shoes should be labeled** with your dancer's name or initials.
- **Shoes should be cleaned** with a damp cloth and mild soap.
  - Strings should be tucked into ballet slippers.
- **Hair** should be neat.
  - Hip Hop Show performers, please see information sheet
  - All Winter Concert performers will wear a LEFT part, LOW bun with head pieces on the right.
- **Make-up should be applied heavily.** (Brown eye shadow, blush, dark red or pink lipstick)
- **Underpants should not be worn** under costumes. Pink tights worn for ballet classes and tan tights for tap, jazz, hip hop and contemporary.
- **No jewelry, hair wraps, temporary tattoos or other accessories** should be worn during Dress Rehearsal or performances.
- Regular JLDC classes held Tuesday, 1/22. JLDC will operate on an amended schedule, Wed 1/23-Sun 1/27.

### DRESS REHEARSAL

- **Dancers should arrive**
  - At Regis College Fine Arts Theater 15 minutes prior to their scheduled Dress Rehearsal time.
  - In costume with all accessories and hair worn per guidelines provided.
- **All parents**
  - Should park cars at rear of the theater (cars in the drop-off circle in front of the building will be towed)
  - Are welcome to watch from the balcony and take photos/videos
  - Cameras and iphones will NOT allowed during the Recital; a professional video will be available for purchase

### JLDC PERFORMANCES

- **Dancers**
  - Should arrive at Regis College Fine Arts Theater **45 minutes before performance time in costume with hair and make-up performance-ready.**
  - Will sit with their class and be chaperoned backstage for the duration of the performance
  - Will participate in the performance bows
- **All Parents**
  - Are requested to settle their dancer in their assigned dressing room with their group, and enter the theater as quickly as possible.
  - Should retrieve their dancer directly from the dressing room after the performance.

### NOTES FOR PARENTS

- **Early Release Vouchers**
  - Must be filled out by parent and returned to Katelin at the front desk by Thursday, January 24th.
- **Babes-In-Arms Policy**
  - In consideration of our entire student body and their families, and in compliance with Weston Ordinance Fire Codes, we must firmly request that families with small children (infants and toddlers on laps and in carriages) make prior child care arrangements for their youngest children, as **we cannot admit "babes-in-arms" to the recitals.** We realize that you may wish to bring your youngest children, but we are governed by circumstances beyond our control. We appreciate your cooperation. No carriages will be allowed in the theater.
